

DRAFT NEW REGIONAL AIR PLAN - RELEASED FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

The Regional Council is seeking your feedback a draft *NEW* Regional Air Plan. The current Regional Air Plan has been operative since 2003 and was reviewed in 2015. The review found that the current plan needed updating and the recommendation was to replace this with a second generation Regional Air Plan, referred to as the “draft New Plan”.
